## **President's Message**

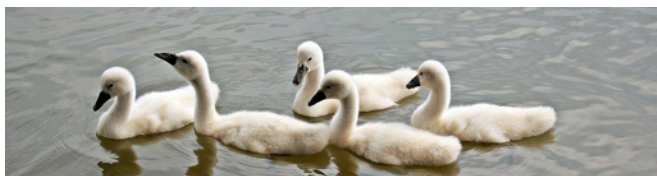
I'd rather be working on my flower beds. So here goes. Sunny this morning and rain this afternoon.
